Interface language

Important: the Examiner simulator user interface (menus, buttons, exam screens, results) is available in English only. This guide is provided in several languages to help you get started, but all labels inside the application remain in English.

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Interface language

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1. Overview

Examinator is an IT certification exam simulation platform (Microsoft, CompTIA and custom programmes) for timed practice with detailed feedback.

The left-hand menu opens Home, the search bar, Certification tracks, Profile, Calendar and User guide.

2. Create an account and sign in

- Open Register from the left-hand menu.
- Enter first name, last name and email, then submit.
- No password is required: the same email signs you back in.
- After registration, your account waits for administrator approval.

3. Access to simulators

- Only an administrator can approve your account and grant exam simulators.
- While pending, you can browse the catalogue but cannot start a simulation.
- If an exam shows Access denied, contact the administrator.

4. Browse the catalogue

- Use Certification tracks for Microsoft, CompTIA and custom programmes.
- Open a certification family to see available exams.
- Start simulation is enabled only when access is approved and the pool is ready.

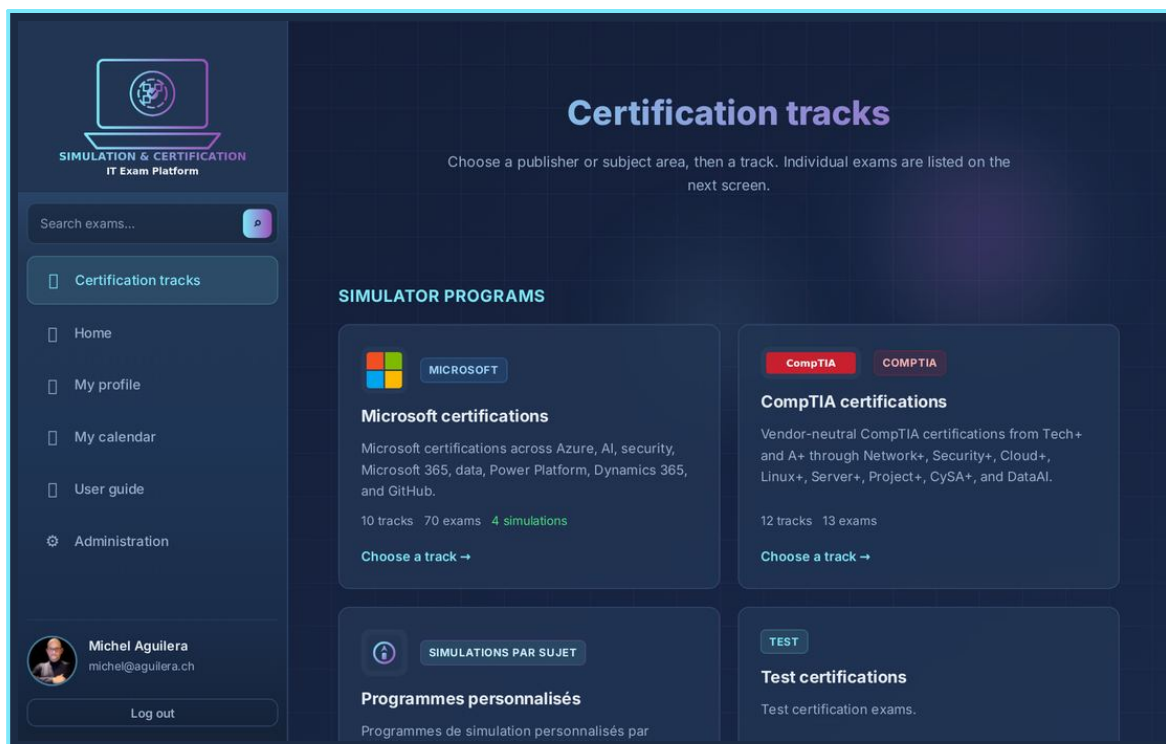


Figure — Certification tracks catalogue

5. Search for a simulator

- Use the Search exams... bar at the top of the left-hand menu, available on every page.
- Enter one or more keywords (exam code, title, vendor, level, role, product...), for example AZ-900, Azure or Security, then submit.
- Multiple words narrow the search: all tokens must match.
- The results page lists matching simulators; open the briefing or the related track. You can also go to /catalog/search.

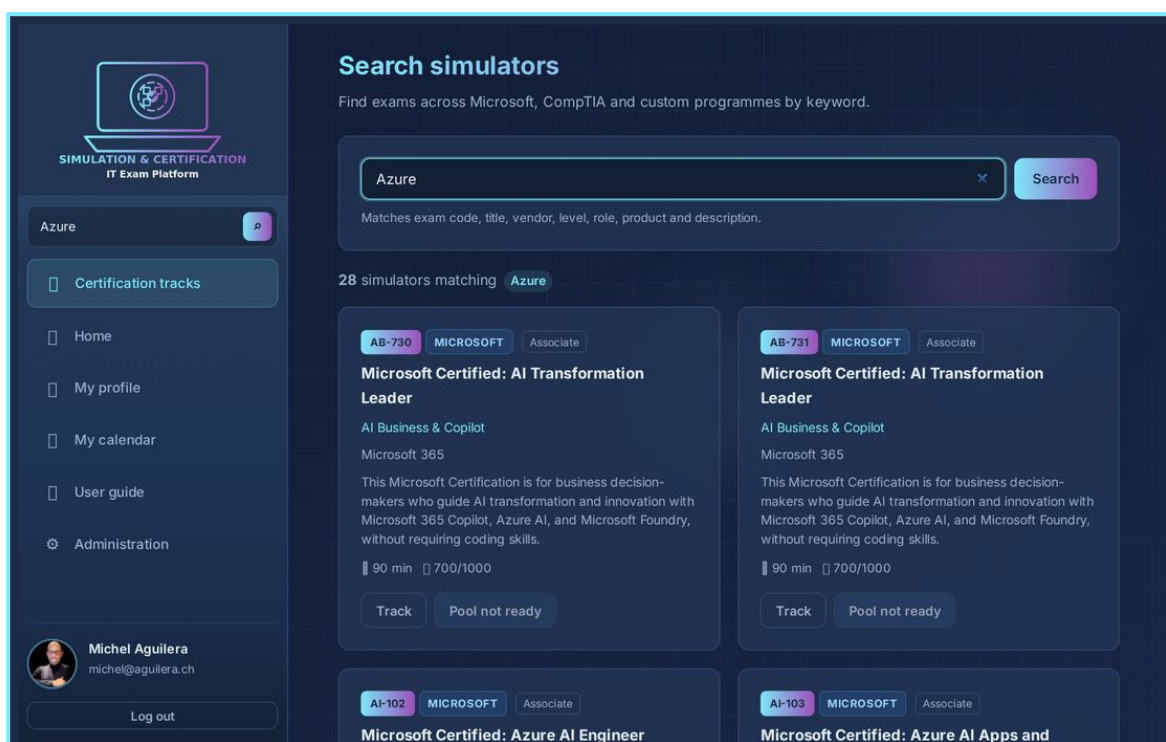


Figure — Simulator search (sidebar bar and results)

6. Take a simulation

- Briefing: read the rules, then click Start exam.
- During the exam: countdown timer, Previous / Next and question grid.
- Submit with Submit exam, or wait until time expires.

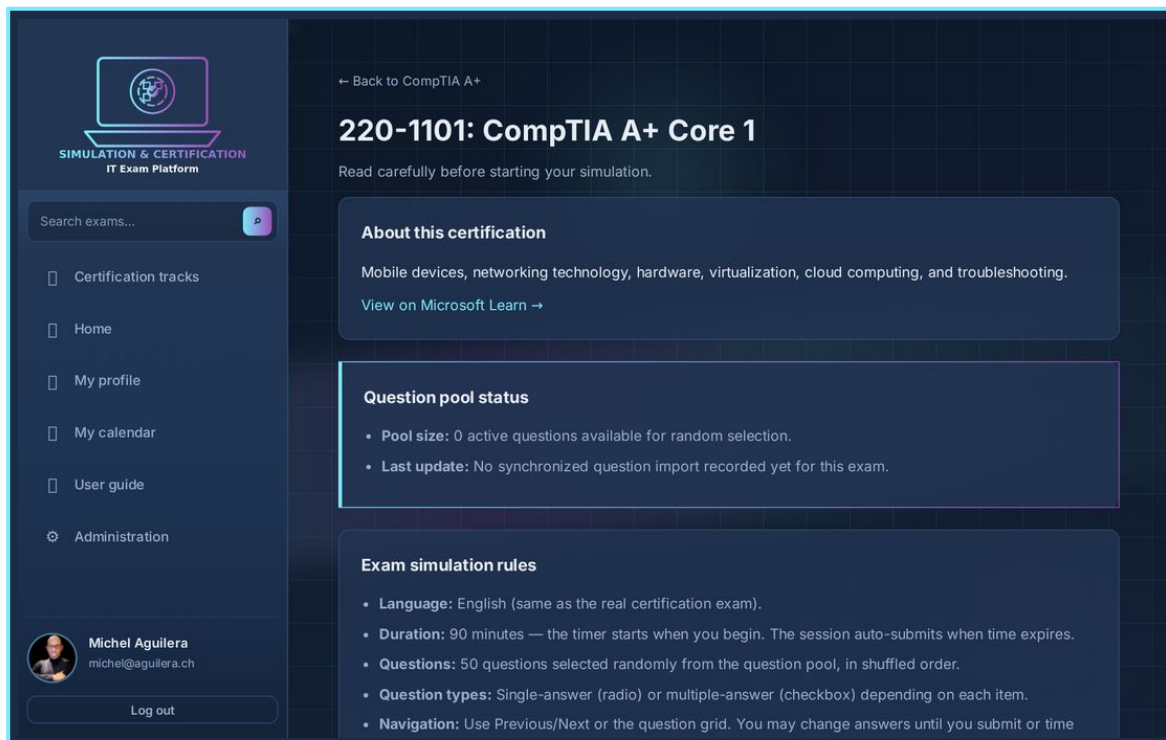


Figure — Briefing before starting the simulation

7. Review your results

- Results shows overall score, counts and section breakdown.
- Question review lists your answers, correct options and explanations.
- Use Retry to practise the same exam again.

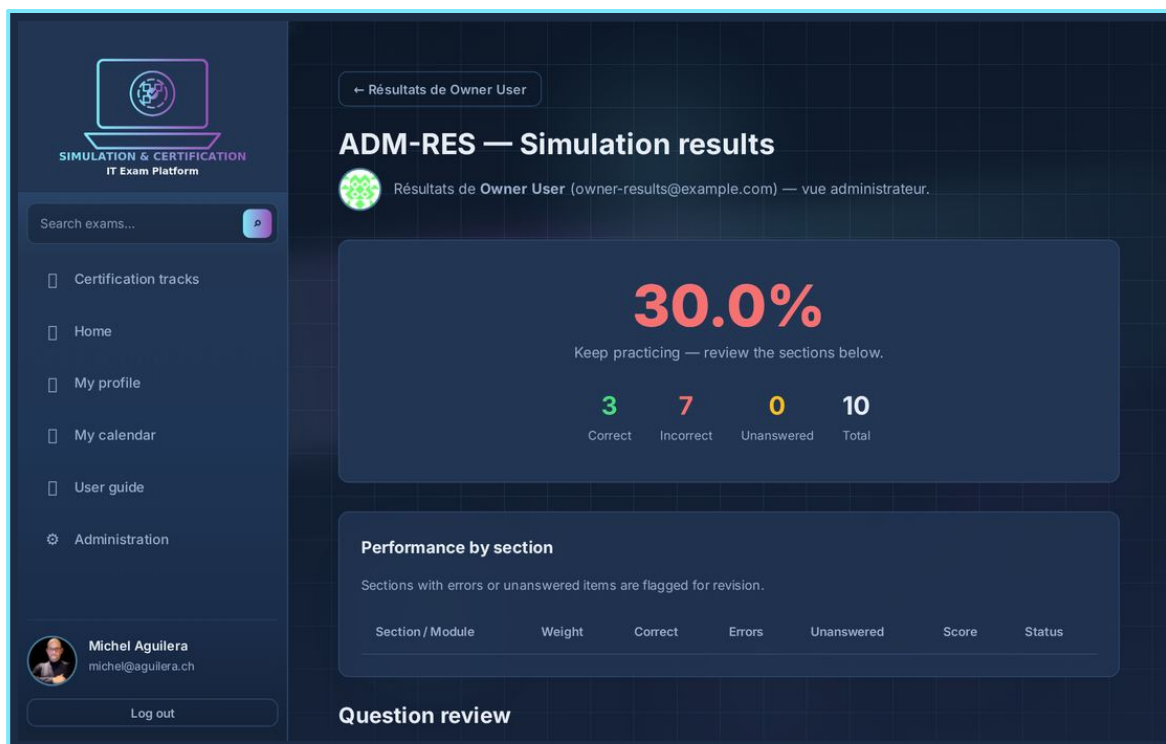


Figure — Results (score, sections, question review)

8. Profile and PDF export

- My profile shows statistics and full attempt history.
- Under Summary by exam, click Export PDF for a per-exam report.

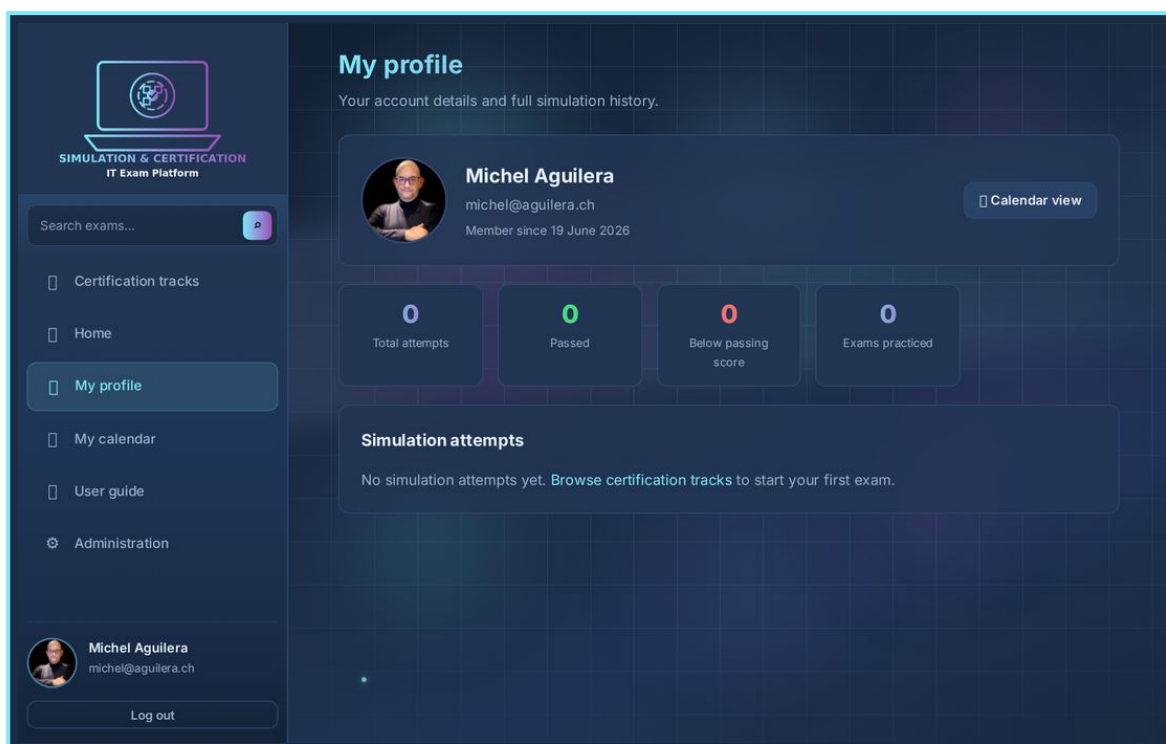


Figure — My profile (history and PDF export)

9. Calendar

- My calendar displays sessions on a monthly grid.
- Click a session to open its results.

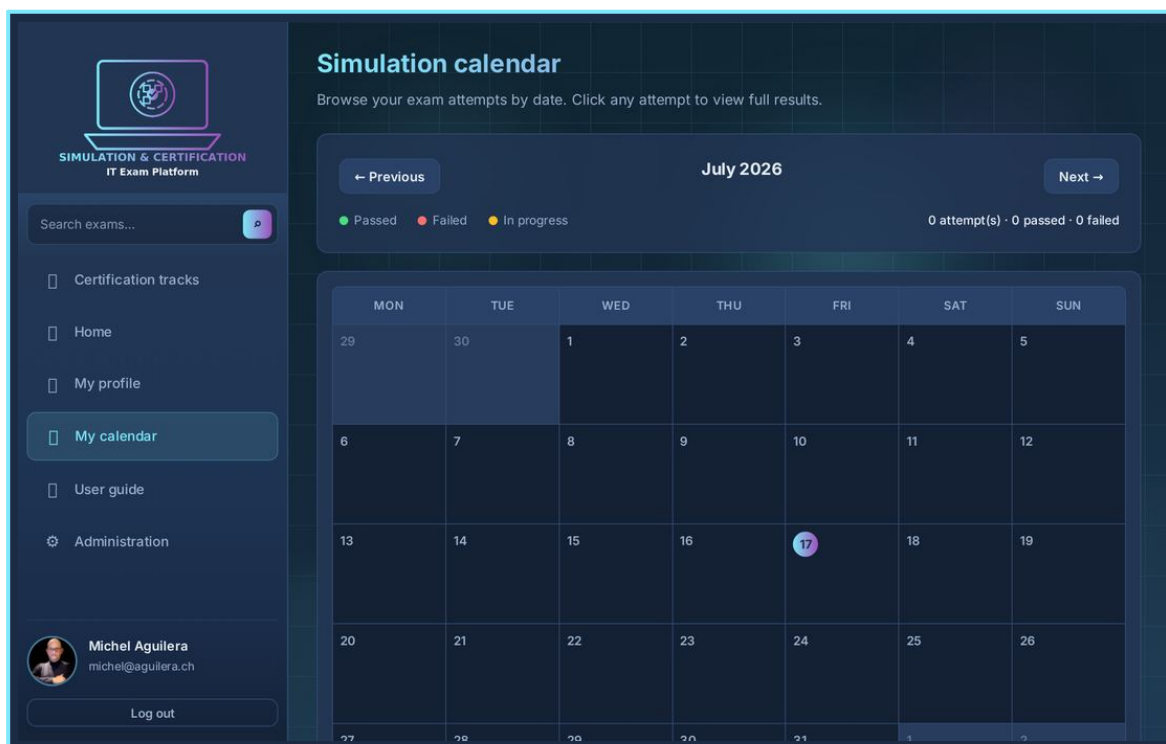


Figure — My calendar (monthly sessions)

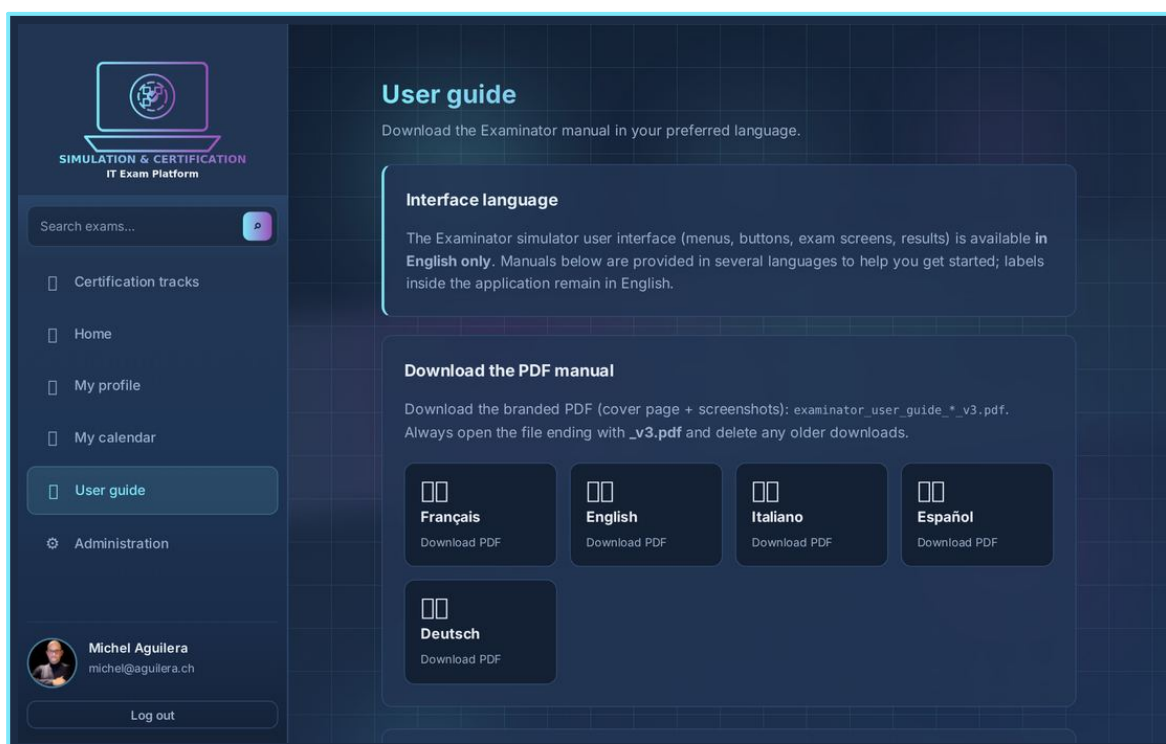


Figure — User guide (PDF language selection)

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
